- Hotel Eden - legendary Dorchester Collection hotel overlooking Rome

- Roscioli - legendary Roman restaurant and salumeria
- Armando al Pantheon - classic Roman cuisine near the Pantheon
- Pierluigi - refined seafood in Piazza de Ricci
- Da Enzo al 29 - famous trattoria in Trastevere
- Il Pagliaccio - Michelin starred fine dining

Top Experiences

- Visit the Colosseum, Roman Forum, and Palatine Hill
- Explore Vatican City including St Peters Basilica and the Sistine Chapel
- Walk through Piazza Navona, the Pantheon, and the Trevi Fountain
- Explore Trastevere for restaurants and nightlife

Suggested 7 Day Rome Itinerary

Day 1	Arrival in Rome. Check into hotel and evening walk to the Spanish Steps and Trevi Fountain.
Day 2	Explore the Colosseum, Roman Forum, and Palatine Hill.
Day 3	Visit Vatican City including St Peters Basilica and the Sistine Chapel.
Day 4	Walk through Piazza Navona, Pantheon, and Campo de Fiori.
Day 5	Explore Trastevere neighborhood and dine in traditional trattorias.
Day 6	Visit Villa Borghese gardens and the Borghese Gallery.
Day 7	Morning espresso and shopping near Via Condotti before departure.

Rome Travel Notes

- Reserve major attractions such as the Vatican Museums and Colosseum in advance.
- Many of Rome's greatest sights are best explored on foot.
- Early mornings and evenings are the best times to explore major landmarks.
- Rome pairs well with Florence, Tuscany, or the Amalfi Coast.
