CIVITA DI BAGNOREGIO

Hidden Gem of Lazio

Civita di Bagnoregio is one of Italy's most dramatic hilltop villages. Founded more than 2500 years ago by the Etruscans, the town sits on a plateau of volcanic rock above the Lazio countryside and is reached by a dramatic pedestrian bridge.

Suggested Half Day Visit

Arrive in Bagnoregio and cross the pedestrian bridge to Civita.

Explore the medieval streets and historic piazza.

Enjoy lunch overlooking the countryside.

Return across the bridge and continue to nearby Orvieto.

- Civita is car free and accessed by a pedestrian bridge
- Best visited early morning or sunset
- Most visits last two to four hours

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
