10 Day Amalfi, Capri & Rome Italy Luxury Travel Guide

This ten day itinerary combines the dramatic Amalfi Coast, the glamour of Capri, and a refined finish in Rome. It balances iconic destinations with memorable restaurants, boutique luxury hotels, and experiences that define each place.

Where to Stay

- Hotel Marina Riviera — Amalfi. Elegant terrace hotel overlooking Amalfi harbor.
- Hotel Villa Brunella — Capri. Cliffside boutique hotel with views over Marina Piccola.
- Hotel Vilòn — Rome. Intimate luxury hotel near Piazza di Spagna.

Where to Eat

- Da Gemma — Amalfi. Refined coastal cuisine and Amalfi classics.
- Marina Grande — Amalfi. Seaside dining overlooking the harbor.
- Da Paolino — Capri. Iconic restaurant set beneath lemon trees.
- La Fontelina — Capri. Legendary beach club restaurant with Faraglioni views.
- Roscioli — Rome. One of the city's most celebrated dining rooms.
- Da Enzo al 29 — Rome. Classic Roman trattoria in Trastevere.

Signature Experiences

- Private Amalfi Coast boat day exploring Positano and hidden coves.
- Sunset visit to Ravello and Villa Cimbrone's famous Terrace of Infinity.
- Capri island boat tour including the Faraglioni rock formations.
- Monte Solaro chairlift in Anacapri for panoramic island views.
- Private Rome walking tour of ancient and historic landmarks.
- Pasta making class with a Roman chef.

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Suggested 10 Day Italy Itinerary

Days 1–3 Amalfi Coast — Arrive along the Amalfi Coast and check into your hotel overlooking the harbor. Spend time exploring the town, relaxing by the sea, and take a private boat day along the coastline to Positano.

Days 4–6 Capri — Ferry to the island of Capri and settle into your hotel overlooking Marina Piccola. Take a boat around the island, visit the Faraglioni rocks, explore Anacapri, and enjoy long seaside lunches.

Days 7–10 Rome — Finish your trip with four nights in Rome. Explore the historic center, enjoy a private walking tour of the Colosseum and Roman Forum, take a pasta making class, and dine at some of the city's most celebrated restaurants.

Italy Travel Notes

- July is peak season on the Amalfi Coast and Capri, so reservations should be made well in advance.
- Ferries are the easiest and most scenic way to travel between Amalfi and Capri.
- This itinerary works particularly well for couples and honeymoon travelers.
- With boutique luxury hotels and private experiences, a realistic land budget is approximately \$13K–\$14K for two travelers.
